

***Identifying Satan’s Role in Transhumanism,  
AI, and the Internet:  
The Mechanism <sup>1</sup> of Daniel 7:23***

*A White Paper – Jay Jusino – Equipping Teachers InC, 12/10/25*

**ABSTRACT**

Of God’s creation, man alone is made in God’s image. The first attributes of God mentioned in the Bible (Gen. 1:1) are that God [Heb. *Elohim*] exists in plurality (unity) and that He is a/the creator. Man therefore seeks to live in social unity and exhibits tremendous creativity. From Gen. 11:6, this creativity, combined with human unity, is expressed by God Himself as infinite creative potential: “nothing they purpose to do will be impossible for them.” Notably, this potential is bent toward rebellion against God (Gen. 11, Ps. 2:1-2). Angelic beings (fallen or not), while possessing many common attributes of man, do not exhibit the creative potential of mankind. Yet, fallen angels can, and actually do, use mankind in order to achieve their creative goals (Gen. 6:1-4). Satan’s ultimate goal is to become, or to be like, God (Gen. 3:5, Isa. 14:12-14). In order to accomplish this goal, he must be, or become, both a “creator” (like God) and he must also possess God-like capabilities, namely, being omnipotent, omnipresent, and omniscient. Since Satan is not God, is not creative, and does not exist every where at all times possessing all power, he must employ a plausible mechanism by which to accomplish his stated agenda of being “like the most High” (Isa. 14:14). This mechanism has become clear as the passage of time has progressed toward the climax of earth history, just as the prophet Daniel predicted. Daniel was told to “seal up the book until (Heb. ‘*ad* ) the end of time” (or “time of the end”) at which time “knowledge will increase” and he indicated that these things would become at that time discernible by stating in context that “those who have insight will understand” (Dan. 12:4; 10). The mechanism broadly defined is that because man is made in God’s image and Satan is not, that Satan needs to employ (use) mankind to literally create the means by which Satan can rule as God (2 Thes. 2:4; 9; Rev. 13:4). This is accomplished through the discovery of, and eventual mastery of, the code of life, namely, the DNA molecule and also through the development of the internet (world-wide-web), the *Internet of Things* (IoT), the *Internet of Bodies* (IoB), Artificial Intelligence, and therefore the final total surveillance state. This is done by ever increasing scientific discovery and technological advancement. This technological capability makes the beast of Daniel 7:23 “different from all the other kingdoms” allowing the final beast to “devour the whole earth and tread it down and crush it.” While the culmination of this will become totally functional at the end of Rev. 13 through the mark of the beast, the system, including both the technological capabilities and the social narrative allowing this to function at that time, are in the full swing of construction at this current time in history. The Christian response is to evangelize, be sober, alert, to expose, to resist and stand firm against the schemes of the devil while avoiding fatalistic complacency.

**Note:** This paper does not seek to identify the beast of Dan. 7/Rev. 13, neither does it offer any sort of time ultimatum for his advent (though it does assume a recognition of the season of the Lord's return). Rather, 1). **it uncovers** the tools and methods by which such a one will be able to operate, 2). **it demonstrates** that his "coming is in accord with the activity of Satan, with all power and signs and false wonders, and with all the deception of wickedness..." and 3). **it suggests** a counter mechanism by which followers of Christ may seek to stand firm against his schemes ["the schemes (Gk. *Methodia*) of the devil" – Eph. 6:11]. Lastly, this paper does not advocate an anti-technology<sup>2</sup> position but instead suggests that there is much room for logical and practical caution for the Christian in this arena.

## Introduction

Daniel 7:23 and Revelation 13:17-18 predict a world (global) government at the culmination of the ages.

"Thus he [the angel] said: 'The fourth beast will be a fourth kingdom on the earth, which will be different from all the other kingdoms and **will devour the whole earth and tread it down and crush it.**'"

Dan. 7:23

"And **he causes all**, the small and the great, and the rich and the poor, and the free men and the slaves, to be given a mark on their right hand or on their forehead, and he provides that **no one will be able to buy or to sell**, except the one who has the mark, either the name of the beast or the number of his name."<sup>3</sup>

Revelation 13:17-18

Applying logic and a grammatical historical hermeneutic to Daniel 12:4 and 12:10 ...

"But as for you Daniel, seal up the book **until the end of time** [some translations, "until the time of the end"]; many will go back and forth and knowledge will increase."

Daniel 12:4

"... but those who have insight will understand ..."

Daniel 12:10

However, just like a knife or a gun (technology) can be used for good or for evil, knowing that "the heart is more deceitful above all else and desperately sick [wicked] ..." (Jer. 17:9), men without the Spirit of God (who "delight in doing evil" – Prov. 2:14) will use whatever technology exists for evil. **It is wise to understand the nature of this use** as it leads to human slavery and death, both physical and spiritual (note Prov. 24:11-12 – "Deliver those who are being taken away to death, and those who are staggering to slaughter" ...).

That narrative will include everything, meaning, all behaviors and choices arising from thoughts must align with the name of the beast. This is global unity at its peak.

... leads to the conclusion that as the time of the end draws nearer and nearer, the prophetic Scriptures will become increasingly clear in a proportional manner. This idea is foundational to the development of the following thesis.

## Thesis

The nature of man, being made in God's image, and the nature of Satan (*not* made in God's image), being desirous to usurp God's position as Creator and thus Ruler (with the authority) of the universe, explains the modern/current rush to connect all things, both living and inanimate, together under AI algorithmic control, pushing rapidly toward the final form of earthly human government and thus the fulfillment of biblical prophecy.

## Man – Made in God's Image

The distinctive feature of **man alone** is that he is "made in God's image" (Gen. 1:27). Angels and animals are not made in God's image.

While it is true that God is, to the human mind, both "unsearchable" and "unfathomable" (Rom. 11:33), the Bible clearly reveals attributes of God that give us somewhat of a working understanding of who God is. In developing this working definition of God, in Genesis 1:1 we see the first two attributes that help us grasp just who He is. <sup>5</sup>

"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth."

The first attribute is that "God" [Heb. *Elohim*] is plural. The second attribute, is that God is the Creator (implied from "God created"). Now,

"God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them." (Gen. 1:27).

This paper will focus on these first two attributes in Gen. 1:1, namely, that God is foremost *the* (singular) Creator existing in plurality (God is one – Deut. 6:4), that is, in perfect unity. If man then is made in His image, then he is also creative by design and exists best, by design, in (or for) perfect

unity. Both ideas will be developed more below, starting with the creative attribute first. But furthermore, and not necessarily unique to mankind (as angels likely share this attribute with man), mankind is super-smart<sup>6</sup> – and that from God’s own Word! Gen. 11:6 states,

“The LORD said, “Behold, they are one people, and they all have the same language. And this [building a city and tower whose top was to be in the heavens] is what they began to do, and now **nothing which they purpose to do will be impossible for them.**”

The Lord’s statement at the end of the verse suggests that man possesses not just a rudimentary creative capacity,<sup>7</sup> but on the contrary, an **infinite**<sup>8</sup> **creative potential**. “Nothing they purpose to do will be impossible for them” is a strong statement from the Creator Himself. Now because mankind has fallen (Gen. 3, Jer. 17:9, Rom. 3:10, et. al.), if one combines man’s creativity with his capacity for wickedness, then man has an infinite creative potential for evil, deviation, wickedness, corruption, etc. This fact explains why, in Gen. 6:3, the Lord reduced the human lifespan to 120 yrs.<sup>9</sup>

“Then the LORD said, “My Spirit shall not strive with man forever, because he also is flesh; nevertheless his days shall be one hundred and twenty years.”

The wickedness developing out of man’s infinite creative potential at Babel moved God to intervene in a miraculous manner to prevent mankind from gaining his unified purpose (making a name for themselves as “one people” in defiance of God’s command to fill the earth – Gen. 11:4). In this account is clearly seen the hand of Satan using (inducing, leading, etc.) man as an agent to advance his own rebellion against God.<sup>10</sup> Psalm 2:1-2 reveals the pattern first seen at Babel well,

“Why are the **nations** in an uproar and the **peoples** devising a vain thing? The **kings** of the earth take their stand and the rulers take **counsel together against** the LORD and **against** His Anointed... ”

Rebellion in its full form is a collective unification effort. Unification in Christ is good. Any and all unification outside of Christ is, or will end in, rebellion against God.<sup>11</sup>

Thus the use of the word infinite here does not mean God can’t check man’s creativity. Just as God had to check banish Adam and Eve from the Garden of Eden so that they would not eat of the tree of life and live “forever” (an infinite time to come), so too, God had to check man’s creativity at Babel in order for the rebellion to be restrained.

## Satan – Not Made in God’s Image

Satan, being angelic, and not human, is therefore not creative by nature.<sup>12</sup> If Satan wants to be “like God,”<sup>13</sup> then he must gain mastery over the business of creating. Furthermore, since Satan is not a creator by nature, the only things he can use are things already created. Satan thus both needs and uses man (who is part of the creation / already created), who has infinite creative potential, to aid him (in rebellious unity) in any creativity that he might want to engage in.<sup>14</sup>

While the following point is not a logically necessary component for one to accept or embrace the point just advanced, it is nevertheless supportive and helps to bridge gaps in understanding. It will therefore be developed below but not relied upon as any sort of proof-text.

The book *Fallen: The Sons of God and the Nephilim*, by Dr. Tim Chaffey, Content Manager of Attractions for Answers in Genesis at the Creation Museum and Ark Encounter in North and Central Kentucky,<sup>15</sup> is perhaps the definitive work on the subject of the Nephilim of Gen. 6:1-4.

“Now it came about, when men began to multiply on the face of the land, and daughters were born to them, that **the sons of God** saw that the **daughters of men** were beautiful; and they took wives for themselves, whomever they chose. Then the LORD said, “My Spirit shall not strive with man forever, because he also is flesh; nevertheless his days shall be one hundred and twenty years.” The Nephilim were on the earth in those days, and also afterward, when the **sons of God came in to the daughters of men, and they bore children to them.** Those were the mighty men who were of old, men of renown.”

Dr. Chaffey writes,

“The Bible tells us that rebellious angelic beings (Heb. *Bene ha’elohim*) married women, and their offspring were the Nephilim (giants). This was a sin against the natural order [cf. Jude v. 6] and contributed to the overall depravity of man that brought about the judgment of the Flood.”<sup>16</sup>

The image of God distinction was not bestowed upon the beasts nor the angels, but man. So, while there is no text of Scripture that states “angels are not made in God’s image,” it logically follows from Gen. 1:26-28. As an example, the text does not have to state that animals are not made in God’s image for the reader to grasp that that is in fact the case. The same is true regarding the angels.

While there are several competing interpretations of this text in disagreement over just who the “sons of God” were, it is beyond the scope of this work to argue those points here. Suffice it to say, the conclusion (above) that Dr. Chaffey arrives at as a result of his 500 pg. dissertation, is in agreement with this work's assertion. It thus provides, if correct, a clear example of how the angelic world cannot create on its own, but must use humans (sub-creators – creators under God [i.e., in God's image]) to accomplish any such feat.

## Satan – His Ultimate Goal

From Isa. 14:12-14, it is easily drawn that Satan either wants to be God, or, perhaps he thinks he is God.

“How you have fallen from heaven, O star of the morning [**Heb. Helel; i.e. shining one; Latin = “Lucifer”**], son of the dawn! You have been cut down to the earth, You who have weakened the nations!

“But you said in your heart, ‘**I will** ascend to heaven; **I will** raise my throne above the stars of God, And **I will** sit on the mount of assembly in the recesses of the north. ‘**I will** ascend above the heights of the clouds; **I will make myself like the Most High.**’”<sup>17</sup>

Satan tempted Eve with the same basic argument in Gen. 3:5, namely, “and you will be like God...”

“For God knows that in the day you eat from it your eyes will be opened, **and you will be like God**, knowing good and evil.”

In Revelation 13 it is clear that at the culmination of the ages, Satan [the Dragon/Devil (Rev. 20:2)], will be “worshipped” (“like God”) by “the whole earth...”

“And the whole earth was amazed and followed after the beast [a beast is a king / kingdom as per Dan. 7:17]; **they worshiped the dragon** because he gave his authority to the beast” [the beast being, namely, the “man of lawlessness” or “son of destruction” who will “take his seat in the temple of God, **displaying himself as being God...**” --- 2 Thes. 2:3-4] (Rev. 13:3-4).

## Satan – The Mechanisms <sup>18</sup> [methodia – Eph. 6:11] to Obtain His Ultimate Goal

### Transhumanism, Artificial Intelligence, & Unification

As just noted above, the appeal to “be like God” exists for humans as well as for Satan because while mankind and angel-kind do not share creative capacity, they do share pride as a fundamental weakness. This is instrumental for Satan, as he can then use man’s pride to his advantage. In order for Satan to exert authority over living things, he must be their “creator.” Even small children naturally grasp (without being necessarily taught) that creators have authority over their creations. A car or plane made of *Legos* becomes the property of its builder (creator), the child. Even a parent would **not** (though they may own the *Legos*) generally disassemble that car or plane made by their child without their child’s permission. This is because the creator/authority principle that is built in to mankind as part of the natural order of things would make a parent disassembling it a moral offense to the child. Therefore, since the code of life is DNA, Satan must somehow master this most important molecule (which is matter already created by God) in order to gain this authority. Modification of DNA within a species is considered a patentable event. Creators of patents have authority over, and the rights to profits made from, those patents.

Restating the two relevant concepts from above then, for Satan to carry out his aim of becoming God, he needs help from man (who has infinite creative potential) and also must attain mastery over DNA manipulation. In order to join Satan in the quest to “be like God” man needs increasingly sophisticated technology to pull off the feat (remember, “**nothing which they purpose to do will be impossible for them**” – Gen. 6:11).

It just so happens that such a discipline exists in the world today who’s goal is to become [“be like”] God. Actually, there are two: **Transhumanism** and **Artificial Intelligence**, or **AI**.

The book is NOT about AI nor computers, but it was the IBM punch card technology that was their direct predecessor. It was this technology that allowed the Nazi’s so much “success” in their human extermination efforts. Had these methods been widely known and acted upon by allied forces, a great many more Jews (and others) would have survived. Furthermore, it is this same company (IBM), that pioneered the first computers, the first mass produced computer (the IBM 650), the first language / speech recognition (“Shoebox,” 1962), pioneered “machine learning,” algorithms, and image processing. No longer does it take any real work at imagination in order to conceive just how the beast of Dan. 7:23 can “crush” the whole earth and how the mark of the beast (Rev. 13:15-18) can be implemented. We've established then that Satan must employ humans to develop mastery over DNA (the transhumanism part – see below) regarding the “creator” attribute of God seen in Gen. 1:1.<sup>19</sup> And since Satan is not omniscient, omnipresent, nor omnipotent,<sup>20</sup> he must again use man's infinite creative potential (for evil) to build and develop the technology infrastructure that culminates in some application of that technology that will enable him to gain this level of ability and power. Something like ... Artificial Intelligence. Hence, we see the captivation the world has with DNA, AI, and human unity.

## Transhumanism

Transhumanism is “the theory that science and technology can help human beings develop beyond what is physically and mentally possible at the present time ... where man supposedly **ascends to godhood and life extension** ... Transhumanism asserts that with all the new technologies available, mankind will be able solve every challenge it faces.”<sup>21</sup> Transhumanism has also been described as ... “technologically mediated evolution”<sup>22</sup> ... with a vision to ... “... **obtain eternal life for the human body, or at least the human brain**”... [with] “self optimization, colonization of space, **and immortality.**”<sup>23</sup>

An extremely important link to both the past and the future regarding transhumanism is the fact that the word itself was coined by Julian Huxley, grandson of Thomas H. Huxley (“Darwin’s Bulldog”), to replace the term *eugenics* because Hitler had given it a bad name. Huxley said,

“The human species can, if it wished, transcend itself – not just sporadically ... but in its entirety, as humanity. **We need a name for this new belief. Perhaps transhumanism will serve.** Man remaining man, but transcending himself, by realizing new possibilities of and for his human nature.”<sup>24</sup>

For the transhumanist vision of eternal life to be realized, DNA must be understood and able to be readily manipulated and improved upon. From even before the discovery of DNA’s shape of a double helix in the 1950’s by Watson and Crick, through the completion of the human genome project in 2003 and beyond, steady advancements in many different fields of technology have accelerated<sup>25</sup> the transhumanist goal. CRISPR technology has been key for the modern manipulation of DNA.

“*Clustered Regularly Interspaced Short Palindromic Repeats* is a technology that research scientists use to selectively modify the DNA of living organisms. CRISPR was adapted for use

in the laboratory from naturally occurring genome editing systems found in bacteria.”<sup>26</sup>

This ability to selectively modify DNA in living organisms is powerful and has birthed a wide variety of applications in “agriculture [e.g., GMO foods<sup>27</sup>], medicine, environmental sciences, fisheries, nanotechnology, bioinformatics, and biotechnology.”<sup>28</sup> mRNA technology also, despite internet searches to the contrary, modifies DNA<sup>29</sup> and opens wide the possibilities for manipulation of living organisms at the individual and species level.

## Artificial Intelligence<sup>30</sup>

Consistent with the above passion transhumanists have to manipulate DNA to create life and remembering that modification of existing life allows patenting [authority] over the “new creation,” consider the following quote from transhumanist Yuval Noah Harari. He is a homosexual professor at Hebrew University in Israel and a key academic (writer and lecturer) championing the cause of the World Economic Forum (WEF). Below he addresses going beyond DNA manipulation and thus creating inorganic “life,” namely, Artificial Intelligence.<sup>31</sup> In the following quote, the emphasis is added (mine).

“In the Bible, God is the Creator. His chief power is to create. He creates animals and plants and humans according to His wishes. Now **we** are gaining the this power to create life, **just like God**. And in a way, we even go beyond the biblical God. Because even if you believe the Bible, the only thing God managed to create are organic beings, all these trees and giraffes and humans, they are just organic. But we are now trying to create inorganic entities, inorganic life forms ... cyborgs, Artificial Intelligence, and so forth. If we succeed, and there’s a very good chance we will, then very soon **we will be beyond the God of the Bible.**”<sup>32</sup>

It appears that the dream of being “like God” seems to have been replaced by modern transhumanists with the conviction that they will go, as Harari said, “beyond” God’s abilities. Dr. Richard R. Schmidt, D. Min., Ph. D., in his book, *Artificial Intelligence, Transhumanism, & the De-Evolution of Democracy*, accurately lists and then expounds upon the “10 levels of AI.” The 10<sup>th</sup> and final level is where AI becomes “God – like”<sup>33</sup> (i.e., “like God”).<sup>34</sup>

As already introduced above, besides not being creative, Satan is not omniscient, omnipresent, nor omnipotent. In order to be in the class of beings that are “like God,” such attributes are, by definition, necessary. Fully developed AI (and its supporting technology), in theory,<sup>35</sup> provides these attributes namely through, and by, connecting all things and beings together into a global, and very controllable, grid.<sup>36</sup> The grid is animated, so-to-speak, by connecting all things and people (and animals for that matter) to “the cloud” (internet) and by creating a system which allows all connected entities to be able to interact with each other (working together) in a smooth and seamless fashion. This idea is summed up by the word “interoperability.”<sup>37</sup>

By now most people have heard of the internet of things (IoT) and the internet of bodies (IoB). These two phenomena accomplish the needed connectivity and resultant interoperability to allow Satan, through the beast, the ability to “be,” or rather, practically (functionally) be, everywhere all the time which gives the power to act in such a way as to affect all connected entities instantly.<sup>38</sup> The IoT connects all functionally relevant objects to the World Wide Web.<sup>39</sup> Things like computers, phones, lights, automobiles, appliances, utility meters, monitors, etc. Likewise, the IoB connects all functionally relevant living things to the World Wide Web. Basically, anything or anyone who has an IP address becomes part of the World Wide Web. Humans can get an IP address through various existing and proposed methods including via injected nanoparticles, quantum dot “patches,” or “tattoos,” inserted bio-chips (to name some more sophisticated applications) or by simply wearing a device (a “wearable”), clothing, or the most common manner ... the average cell phone (average does not connote low sophistication).

“An Internet Protocol (IP) address is the unique identifying number assigned to every device connected to the internet.”<sup>40</sup>

“If a single chip is embedded within the human body, then in theory every human would become a hub or a node, addressable and traceable within the larger IoT ecosystem and every owned device assigned to that Human IP address.”<sup>41</sup>

Thus, IoB becomes a mere subset of IoT. But the larger point is the ubiquitous (worldwide) control that this interoperability allows. And for its part, the AI algorithms will work in and through this system to regulate, manage, and control each and every “node” (end point – including humans) of the system.<sup>42</sup>

Some say that the projected AI capabilities are over-hyped.<sup>43 44 45</sup> To that idea, consider that the former head of Google, Eric Schmidt, has predicted that AI will be “smarter” (i.e., more capable) than all humans combined by about 2030.<sup>46</sup> Elon Musk likewise envisions connectivity via his Neuralink to allow for a “single collective will for humanity.”<sup>47</sup> An important perspective to consider when analyzing the over-hyped assertion is that while the predictions of these men may be delayed beyond their expected advent, or, may never come about at all, nevertheless, these things are in no uncertain terms what these people very clearly intend and hope to rapidly bring about. In other words, they are taking bold, consistent, and urgent steps to bring these capabilities to pass. This is important for our wisdom’s sake. Furthermore, it must be remembered that “The coming of the lawless one is according to the working of Satan, with all power, signs, and lying wonders, and with all unrighteous deception among those who perish ...” ( 2 Thes. 2:9-10). If Satanic power is at work, then AI is not over-hyped, but under-hyped.

## Unification – DNA, AI, and the Grid

On day 2 of the second Trump administration, President Donald Trump unveiled what is called the Stargate AI Infrastructure Project which was heralded by Oracle CEO billionaire Larry Ellison as a way to personalize cancer mRNA vaccines within 48 hours of detection.

“One of the most exciting things we're working on ... is our cancer vaccine. You can do early cancer detection with a blood test, and using AI to look at the blood test, you can find the cancers that are actually seriously threatening the person. You can make that vaccine,

that mRNA vaccine, you can make that robotically, again using AI, in about 48 hours."

This amounts to an integration of the DNA (biological) with the artificial (AI) into a system of ever increasing monitoring and management (control/regulation).

*The Register* (see associated footnote) explains Ellison's model,

"If governments want in, they'll need to gather all their data – spatial information, economic data, electronic healthcare records including genomic data, and info about infrastructure. Whatever they've got, basically. And put it all in one place to be analyzed by algorithms."<sup>48</sup>

Ellison has said similar things on multiple occasions but one notable occasion was before the World Government Summit (2025) while speaking with former UK Prime Minister Tony Blair,

"The first thing a country has to do is to **unify** all their data so in can be consumed and used by the AI model ... I have to tell the AI model as much about my country as I can ... you have to take all of your health care data, your diagnostic data, your electronic health records, **your genomic data** ... we have to take all of this data we have in our country and move it into a single, if you will, **unified** data platform."<sup>49</sup>

It is important that a note on unification be made as germane to the interoperability (fluid connectedness) of all tech and data and to the nature of man, Satan, and biblical principal. AI applied to everything and everyone via the internet provides the holy grail so-to-speak of Satanic rebellion. This is because it provides, as mentioned above, a scientific real-world capability to create (remember Gen. 6:11 – nothing will be impossible for them), and to literally connect, all things, living and non-living, into an **observable and controllable grid**.<sup>50</sup> But for this grid to function properly (for Satan's purposes) it requires a mindset and willingness of global unity, a concept that goes against all natural desires for freedom, liberty, and the ability for people to follow the biblical directive "to make it your ambition to lead a quiet life and attend to your own business and work with your hands ... so that you will behave properly toward outsiders and not be in any need" (1 Thes. 4:11-12). This natural desire to live free (more unconnected) exists in tension with the human desire for unity, that is, being not isolated and autonomous but part of a larger picture or purpose.

### **Why humans gravitate toward "unity" (Gen. 11:6, Ps. 2:1-2, Rev. 19:19)**

God is one God but existing in three persons [the God the Father, God the Son, God the Holy Spirit]. Therefore, He exists in perfect unity [Gen. 1:1, 1:26; Deut. 6:4] with Himself. As image bearers of God, man then too is made for unity. Certainly one aspect of that is the unity of body, soul, and spirit existing in the same space simultaneously. But additionally, man seeks unity with those outside

himself, i.e., with others. Man naturally seeks this same unity aspect of being made in God's image but the fall has corrupted its expression and fulfillment. Knowing this, Satan presses the design feature by offering fulfillment of this longing for unity but offering rather a counterfeit of it, knowing he'll get many takers. Man also, knowing he is but dust (Eccl. 3:20), finds fulfillment in being part of something bigger than himself.

Satan uses all these proclivities of man to his full advantage. This is why the modern global narrative<sup>51</sup> appeals directly to humans (Christians included) through words like, "together," "we," "our," "us," "collective," "collaborate," "community," "common," "united," "partnership" etc...<sup>52</sup> The gravity of this issue is realized when one notices the consistent theme from ...

Genesis 11 – Mankind's **unification in rebellion against God** under Nimrod – who's name means, "rebellion."<sup>53</sup>

... through ...

Ps. 2 – vv. 1-2 - "Why are **the nations** in an uproar and **the peoples** devising a vain thing? The **kings of the earth** take their stand and the **rulers take counsel together against** the LORD and against His Anointed."

... and finally to ...

Rev. 19:19 – "And I saw **the beast and the kings of the earth and their armies assembled** [ostensibly together] to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army."

... namely, that the unified rebellion against God motif occurs, literally, from the beginning of the Bible to the end.<sup>54</sup> Unification of man, if it is not in Christ, is, or will end in, rebellion against God. Interestingly, Christians are often, it seems, even more susceptible to falling for the Satanic false (global) unity narrative than their non-Christian neighbors. This is because unity, in its designed form, is first and foremost a biblical concept, as noted above, originating in God's very nature. Furthermore, in John 17, Jesus, in His high priestly prayer, focuses on unity between the disciples, Jesus, and the Father<sup>55</sup> not to mention the many other places in the Bible in which the oneness of believers is taught.<sup>56</sup>

An additional important reason that Christians can fall for the global unity narrative is due to a skewed view of eschatology and a categorical rejection of the future tense of many parts of both Daniel and Revelation (as well as other prophetic portions of Scripture). When a Christian is taught by their pastor or other teachers that Daniel’s and John’s prophecies (Revelation) are allegorical (not literal), and that all the prophecies made to Israel are meant for, or fulfilled in, the Church, then it becomes more difficult to pick out the global unity in rebellion against God narrative as being a bad thing.<sup>57</sup> Furthermore, these concepts are tied of necessity to a postmillennial view of the end times. Namely, that the earth will be fully Christianized before Jesus returns. This view is literally opposite and stands in full contradiction to the literal view of Dan. 7:23 and the sobering words of Jesus in Matt. 24:6-12.

“Thus he said: “The fourth beast will be a fourth kingdom on the earth, which will be different from all the other kingdoms and will devour the whole earth and tread it down and crush it.”  
Dan. 7:23

“You will be hearing of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not frightened, for those things must take place, but that is not yet the end. For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom, and in various places there will be famines and earthquakes.  
“Then they will deliver you to tribulation, and will kill you, and you will be hated by all nations because of My name. “At that time many will fall away and will betray one another and hate one another. “Many false prophets will arise and will mislead many. “Because lawlessness is increased, most people’s love will grow cold.  
Matt. 24:6-12

Things will not get better on earth before (or at) the end, but worse.

“Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter times some will depart from the faith, giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons.”  
1 Tim. 4:1

“But evil men and impostors will grow worse and worse, deceiving and being deceived.”  
2 Tim. 3:13

“even to the end there will be war; desolations are determined.”  
Dan. 9:26

The idea (postmillennialism<sup>58</sup>) of things getting better and better (more and more Christian) is not consistent with the many plain and clear prophetic texts (as sampled above). Amillennialism as well, the idea that we are all in the millennium already and Satan is therefore currently bound,<sup>59</sup> does not give

believers a clear pattern by which they will recognize the nearness of Christ's return. It thus produces confusion in regards to the signs of the times<sup>60</sup> including those stressed and articulated in this work. These ideas are most commonly advanced through a systematic Reformed theology that predicts that the future will not devolve into a global tyranny controlled by the Antichrist, but rather build up, better and better, to facilitate and pave the way for the glorious return of Christ. Reformed theology sees a general Christian global unity as a necessary aspect preceding Christ's return. Much of this vein of thought among Reformed teachers is a result of their rejection of any future purpose that God has for the Jewish people, that is, the physical descendants of Abraham, Isaiah, and Jacob.<sup>61</sup> This rejection is a result of an allegorical (non-literal) interpretation of many prophetic texts and thus muddies the water regarding the ability to recognize, again, the signs of the times.

To conclude this section on unification, the more humans are unified, the more easily Satan can exercise practical lordship ("omni") over all of them. This follows logically.

## Summary Statement

Satan uses all the aspects of man being made in God's image to his evil advantage. He employs man's creativity and great intelligence to gain his goal of becoming God by tempting man with that same desire. Then he unifies humanity under this false hope, the hope of immortality (being "like God") in order to achieve that very goal himself. It is this unification itself that, unbeknownst to mankind, allows Satan to dominate them all. This occurs through the mastery of DNA and the application of AI to the entire world, connecting both inanimate things and all living things (IoT / IoB) into a single unified system of interconnectedness (interoperability). This functions as a global narrative enforcement that, when fully mature (@ the time of Rev. 13:16-18), will be required for participation in society. While this system is not yet complete, this is where the current societal momentum is carrying humanity – and at break neck speed!<sup>62</sup>

## How it Will All End

Revelation 13, 2 Thes. 2:3-10, et. al., suggests that Satan will advance far in this endeavor. Not that he will actually become God, but rather he will advance far in his earthly control in his attempt to do it. In Revelation 13, we read that the [first] beast has ...

great authority (to act for 42 months) / great power given by the dragon / power to overcome the saints / no one would even think to wage war with him / all who dwell on earth will worship him

This is because ... (again)

“The coming of the lawless one **is according to the working of Satan, with all power, signs, and lying wonders, and with all unrighteous deception** among those who perish ...”  
2 Thes. 2:9-10

## What is The Christian Response?

The answer to this question could take the space of an entire paper in itself. It will only be briefly addressed here as it is not the main focus of this document. According to the biblical model, **Christians should:** restrain the advance of this evil (2 Thes. 2:7), resist it (Eph. 6:13), stand firm against [this] scheme [Gk. *methodia* – Eph. 6:11) of the devil, avoid joining it but rather expose it (Eph. 5:11), and put on the full armor of God (Eph. 6:13ff) beginning with the belt of truth and the breastplate of righteousness. Nor should we fear or fret (Ps. 37), but be sober and alert (1 Thes. 5:6-8). Neither should we become fatalistically complacent!

Furthermore, just like the Apostle John destroyed the Gnostic Heresy (the popular false narrative of his day) in John 1:14 by stating, “the word became flesh,”<sup>63</sup> so to Christians can destroy the false savior that is put forward by the religious humanists in transhumanism and AI (namely, immortality without God), by using their knowledge of the current issues of our day (namely, the topic of this paper). Consider longtime mathematics professor at Oxford, Dr. John Lennox (author of *2084 – And The AI Revolution*)<sup>64</sup> as he addresses the matter in a highly on-point observation, “the irony of the whole thing is that this race for AI superintelligence is the race to make God and be God. The biblical message is that God became human. It goes in the reverse direction. And I think that’s a very powerful idea.”<sup>65</sup> So what he is showing is that Christians can use the false narrative of our current time to **succinctly preach the gospel** by contrasting it with the truth, namely, that God became man (the Word became flesh) in order to save us from our sin – a stark opposite of the transhuman/AI religious humanism model (the current messianic-like narrative).

A special note on this last point is deserved. Many respond to content such as is contained within this White Paper by saying to themselves (and very often out loud to others) something like, “Well, we can’t change the prophecies. It’s going to come.”<sup>66</sup> There is nothing I can do about it.” And then,

because of this, simply act as if all things will continue on as normal, even dismissing the topic as worthy of any interest or discussion. This is **fatalistic complacency**, a principle that is **not found in the Bible!** Those who assert this view do so not out of wisdom or as a result of biblical study, but out of simplicity, emotion, and/or ignorance.

## Objections and Questions

1. What about Christians and AI, or even, “Christian” AI? Can AI be used for information processing (i.e., for good purposes)?

### Answer

In 1 Chron. 12:32, we read ...

“ [The] ... the sons of Issachar [were] men who understood the times, with knowledge of what Israel should do ...”

The operative point in this is that understanding and knowledge of one’s times have a decidedly and practically functional result. Jesus implied this clearly when he criticize the Pharisees in Matt. 16:2-3...

“When it is evening, you say, ‘It will be fair weather, for the sky is red.’ “And in the morning, ‘There will be a storm today, for the sky is red and threatening.’ Do you know how to discern the appearance of the sky, **but cannot discern the signs of the times?**”

If the Pharisees and Sadducees had understood the times with knowledge, they would have **acted very differently** toward Jesus and the things that he said.

When the tower of Babel was being built, there was, no doubt, some technological invention, perhaps, the newest and latest brick oven [Gen. 11:3] and a newly discovered mortar mixture (recipe), that produced exceptional strength in the then budding (man was repopulating after the Flood) building industry. At this point, some objectors to Nimrod’s system and plan could have recognized what he was doing, namely, acting in proud rebellion against God by unifying man against Him. They recognized that the newest technology of brick building and laying was the key to advancing the rebellion (building the tower). Would it have been morally wrong for them to avoid using that very brick-technology (purchasing from, say, the “Tower of Babel Brick and Mortar Company”) for their own personal homes and out buildings? This author would say probably not, yet this example is not a one-to-one correlation. Unfortunately, things are not so black and white today as then. Suffice it to say, that anyone who uses a normal computer or SMART device (like a phone) today is “using” AI as AI algorithms are already distributed across the modern technological platforms.<sup>67</sup>

The premier Christian expert on technocracy<sup>68</sup> today is Patrick Wood.<sup>69</sup> To loosely quote him, he has said something to the effect, “The only good use for AI is to destroy AI.” Whether one agrees or not with this statement, it provides some very well informed insight into the threat AI poses to society. The example above regarding the analogy to the technology of making bricks at Babel is overly simplistic in that AI, as indicated previously, has many levels. IBM.com states it this way,

“Unlike traditional AI models, which operate within predefined constraints and require human intervention, agentic AI exhibits autonomy, goal-driven behavior and adaptability. The term “agentic” refers to these models’ agency, or, their capacity to act independently and purposefully.<sup>70</sup>

The brick analogy above would correlate more to “traditional AI.” It is the Agentic AI that becomes significantly more problematic. While Agentic AI was born out of earlier phases of AI development, nevertheless, the earlier forms of AI could be quite helpful for data analysis functions. But time and “progress” don’t stop. AI has developed to what some would say is a frightening stage.

“There will be signs in sun and moon and stars, and on the earth **dismay** among nations, in **perplexity** at the roaring of the sea and the waves, **men fainting from fear and the expectation of the things which are coming upon the world**; for the powers of the heavens will be shaken.”  
Luke 21:25-26

As explained above, transhumanism's goal is immortality and for AI, it is to arrive at “God-like AI.” It is clear then that these are satanic movements bent on deceiving the whole earth and then replacing God. Where is the line between using developed technology that is infused within functional society wisely for good or, conversely, to avoid participating in the fruitless deeds of darkness (Eph. 5:11)? How does one “resist in [**this/our**] evil day” and “stand firm against the schemes [Gk. *methodia* – methods – including the schemes that this White Paper has addressed] of the devil”? (Eph. 6:11-13) **The church, unfortunately, does not seem to be asking these types of questions or seem to even have any real interest in them at all.** Hopefully, the next question will give at least food for thought on this matter.

2. What about ministry? Can Christians use AI, the internet, and/or Big Tech for sharing the gospel or for other ministry? I.e., Where does one draw the line regarding Eph. 5:11, “**Do not participate in the fruitless deeds of darkness**, but rather expose them”? What about Eph. 6 ... resist, stand firm ... ?

## Answer

This is a difficult question to answer and even harder to answer succinctly!

First off, the obvious ought to be stated clearly, namely that the phrase “ignorance is bliss” is rooted in the relevant Scripture, “Because in much wisdom there is much grief, and increasing knowledge results in increasing pain” (Eccl. 1:18). The more one knows, the more difficult life becomes as knowledge brings responsibility and accountability to a higher level. Total ignorance of transhumanism and AI’s common goal results in no moral objections, but merely one’s keeping up with the times.<sup>71</sup> Knowledge of what is going on with both of these brings up many moral dilemmas. Many<sup>72</sup> choose ignorance to avoid these dilemmas. Yet the Scripture is clear that though knowledge (and understanding) must be handled rightly,<sup>73</sup> it is nevertheless prudent and wise to do gain knowledge and understanding. It is instrumental in aiding believers in their goal of walking in righteousness.

“The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge (Prov. 1:7)

“The mind of the prudent acquires knowledge, and the ear of the wise seeks knowledge.” (Prov. 18:15)

“So the people without understanding are ruined. (Hos. 4:14)

“Give me understanding that I may observe Your law and keep it with all my heart.” (Ps. 119:34)

Let this author be very clear on another point, that a key motivating cause for this White Paper rests in the principles of Prov. 24:11-12,

**“Deliver those who are being taken away to death, and those who are staggering to slaughter, Oh hold them back.** If you say, “See, we did not know this,” Does He not consider it who weighs the hearts? And does He not know it who keeps your soul? And will He not render to man according to his work?”

This primarily includes bringing attention to the matter,<sup>74</sup> especially to church leadership. Isa. 56:10 states,

“His watchmen are blind, all of them know nothing. All of them are mute dogs unable to bark...”

Let this *not* be true of pastors and elders now, in our time, regarding the dangers presented by transhumanism and AI.<sup>75</sup> The heart of this writer is not to focus on criticizing church leadership, but to alert and encourage them toward sound and timely<sup>76</sup> teaching on this matter. The personal goal for this

writer is simply, “so that I may by all means save some” (1 Cor. 9:22), as v. 11 above directs. And v. 12 above puts one right back into the Eccl. 1:18 slot. Let us not pretend we don’t know.

The second point follows from the above, namely, that it is quite a certain expectation that Christians will be all over the map on their responses on how to answer the question of how to personally handle AI, even if all of them read this work. That said, this author will simply aim to give some food for thought on the matter in hopes of helping each reader think through it all. The first suggestion is that each reader do so prayerfully while continuously asking God for wisdom for each matter that arises.

To actually begin the answer to the question / objection above, I will transition to writing in the first – person.

**Here is what I am NOT saying, stating, nor implying.**

1. I am NOT saying Christians can never use AI, Big Tech, SMART Meters, or be connected to the cloud, the World Wide Web, etc. I am not anyone’s judge (even for myself – 1 Cor. 4:3).
2. I am not saying that ministry (incl. preaching the gospel) can’t or shouldn’t use AI, the internet, or social media. The gospel **has been** and **can be** preached via using such technology. After all, what the enemy means for evil, God means for good.<sup>77</sup> And God’s Word will not return void but will accomplish the work He intends it to accomplish (Isa. 55:11)<sup>78</sup>

**Here is what I am saying**

1. AI (IoT, IoB, the World Wide Web and indeed, social media) is a wide-net Trojan Horse built to steal, kill, and destroy (Jn. 10:10) according to Satan’s intentions and Christians, by-and-large, are ignorant (oblivious) of this to a fault.<sup>79</sup>
  - a. Regarding ministry, it’s a numbers game (see point # 2 above). Which is more impactful? Will more souls be saved through using AI tech, *et. al.* in ministry, or will more souls be saved by warning people of, and extracting them from, the hidden and rapidly rising Satanically led beast system that uses AI tech, *et. al.*, as its key tool?

My current thinking (which, of course, could change) I will state as a question, namely ...

**...is it possible that no contradiction exists <sup>80</sup> between using AI tech for ministry and the gospel in general (Gen. 50:20, Isa. 55:11) while simultaneously alerting users (and people in general) of its dangers (Eph. 5:11, Eccl. 1:18) and advocating a retreat from, and resistance to (Eph. 6:11-13), interoperability and AI dependency [including constant digital surveillance] (1 Cor. 7:23)<sup>81</sup> into better, more free, <sup>82</sup> alternatives?**

It is my observation that this is a discussion that the church at large ought to be currently heavily engaged in. Unfortunately, by and large, it is not. “Ignorance is bliss” seems to be exercising the upper hand.

Let the discussion begin! Prov. 18:13, 18:17, 27:17 <sup>83</sup>
